Exploded View



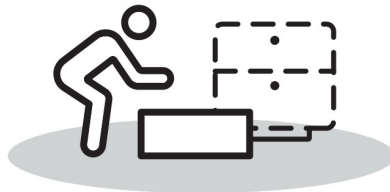
PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches.



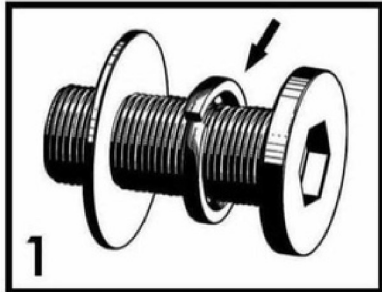
Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

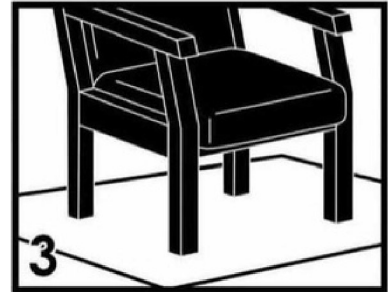
BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES



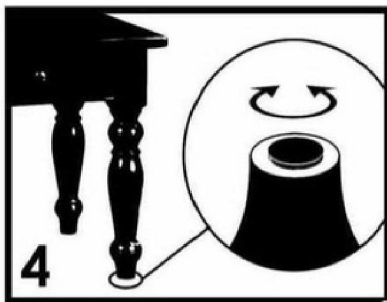
When lock or spring washer is used in an assembly, please make sure the lock or spring washer is placed between the larger flat washer and the head of the screw or bolt.



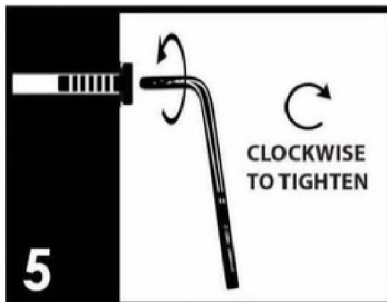
Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes by hand tighten or using the proper hand tool. Only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



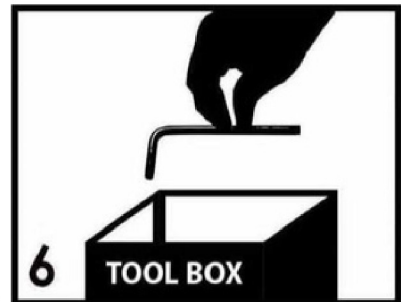
Use cardboard or carpet area when assembling furniture to prevent scratches. Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.



Some furniture comes with height adjustment knobs underneath each leg. To lower or to raise each leg, you need to turn clockwise or counterclockwise, respectively.



Make sure all parts are properly aligned, then use the appropriate hand tool to completely tighten the bolts or screws. Do not use power tools and do not overtighten.



Save the instructions and store the Allen wrench or any supplied tool for later maintenance. After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

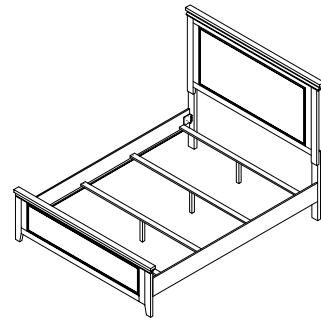

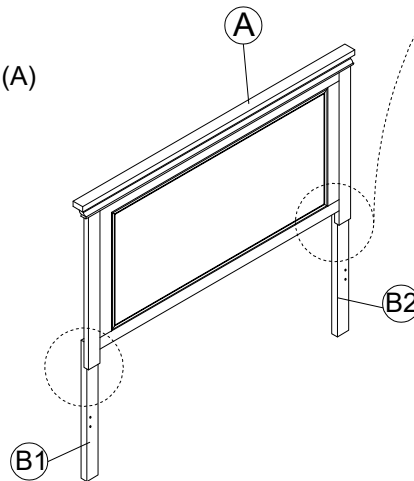
STEP 1 : PASO 1

Back view:

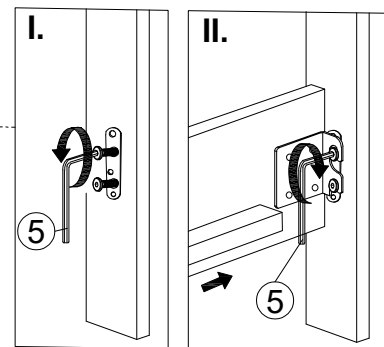
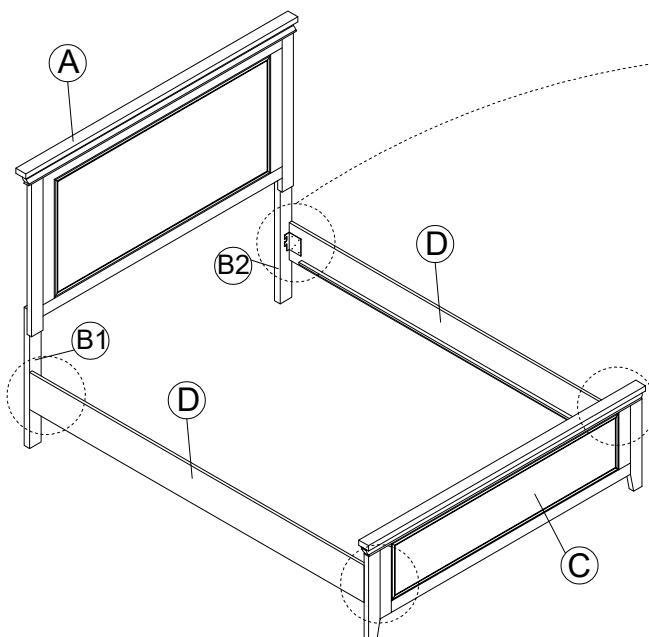
Attach Headboard Leg (B1) (B2) to Headboard (A) by using JCBC M6 x 40mm (1), M6 Spring Washer (2), and M6 Flat Washer (3) on each headboard leg.

Vista posterior:

Fije las patas del cabecero (B1, B2) al cabecero (A) utilizando el perno JCBC M6 x 40 mm (1), la arandela de presión M6 (2) y la arandela plana M6 (3) en cada pata.



STEP 2 : PASO 2

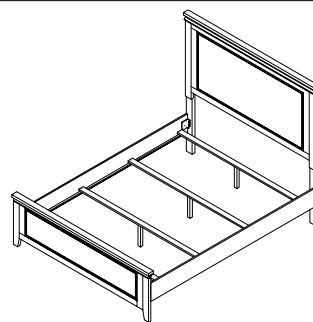


Attach Side Rails (D) to Headboard Leg (B1) (B2) and Footboard (C) using Allen Key M5 (5).

Fije los rieles laterales (D) a las patas del cabecero (B1, B2) y al pie de cama (C) utilizando la llave Allen M5 (5).

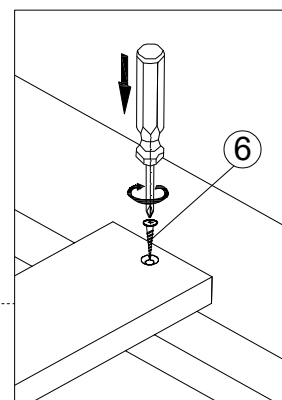
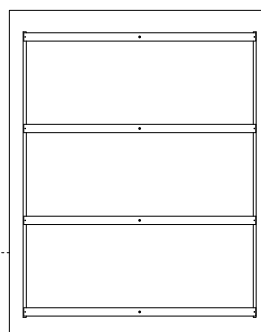
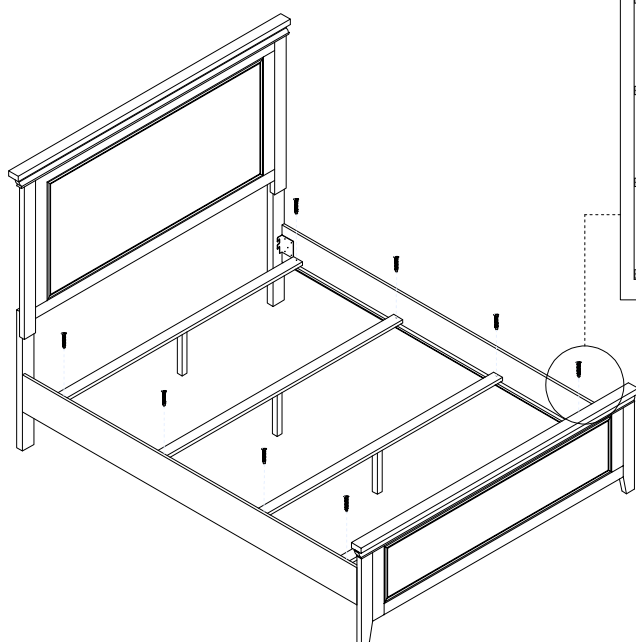
STEP 3 : PASO 3



Attach Slat (E) to Slat Center Support Leg (F) by using JCBC M6 x 50mm (7) and Allen Key M4 (4).

Fije el listón (E) a la pata de apoyo central del listón (F) utilizando el tornillo JCBC M6 x 50 mm (7) y la llave Allen M4 (4).

STEP 4 : PASO 4

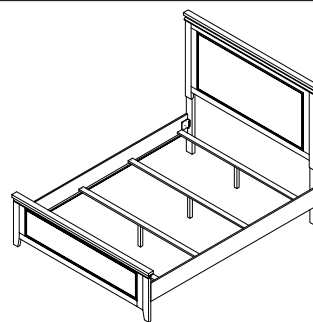


Attach Slat (E) to Side Rail (D) by using CSK Screw M4 x 32mm (6).

Fije el listón (E) al riel lateral (D) utilizando el tornillo CSK M4 x 32 mm (6).
